**Robert Lawson (The Elder) 1652 – 1736.**

**Brothers: William 1713 – 1808; Benjamin 1718 - 1792 & Thomas Satterthwaite 1720 – 90**

**John Dillworth 1691 – 1747. Sons: Thomas 1713 – 86 & William 1716 - 89.**

**John Heathcote 1730 – 58 & Dodshon Foster 1730 – 93.**

**Abraham Rawlinson 1709 – 80. Sons: Henry 1743 – 86; John 1744 – 81 & Thomas 1751 – 1802; Grandson: Abraham 1777- 1829.**

**Thomas Hutton Rawlinson 1712 – 69. Sons: Abraham 1738 – 1803; John 1741 – 99 & Thomas Hutton 1751 – 77. Wife: Mary (Dilworth) 1714 - 86 & Daughter: Lydia (1745 – 98)**
